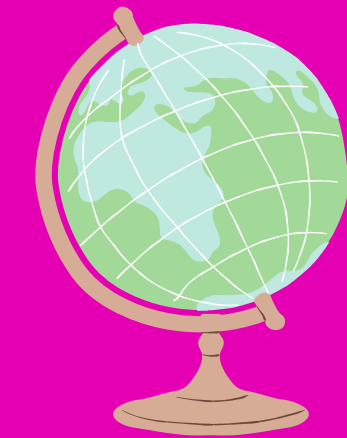
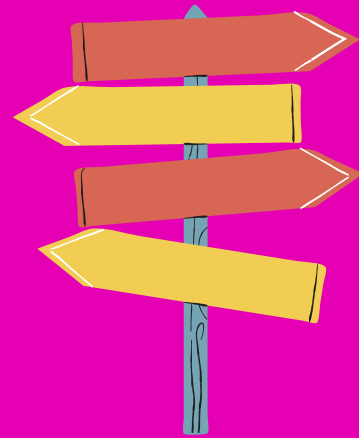
Also, you can join the basic Korean class taught by a friendly professor and practice with Korean students.
